Class Descriptions

NWHA Rules will be followed according to the NWHA Rule book. TWHBEA Versatility Rules in effect for applicable classes.

ADP – All Day Pleasure CP – Country Pleasure – TWH TP – Trail Pleasure - TWH PLS - Park Lite Shod - TWH AOT – Amateur Owned & Trained
OT – Optional Tack (Western, English or breed specific, but not a combination)
Minnesota Bred – Any TWH born in Minnesota

OGB – Open Gaited Breed Any Gaited Breed is eligible to enter. Traditional tack and attire appropriate to the breed may be used, but not a combination. Horses enter the ring at the walk specific to the breed. The walk is of the exhibitor's choice, but shall be the walk specific to the breed. The working walk is a slow even four-beat walk. The head and neck are lowered as the horse stretches into the rider's hand showing relaxation and acceptance of the bit. At the working walk the horse is calm and relaxed. There is no need for restraint on the part of the rider and there is observable slack in the reins. The intermediate gait is of the exhibitor's choice, shall be the gait the breed considers the intermediate gait. The canter or lope is a three-beat gait on the correct lead. The horse is under control.

All Div – Open to horses eligible for any division as outlined by the NWHA rule book. Gait calls will be the same as an All Day Pleasure class – pleasure gait, trail walk, and canter (if applicable).

Novice Horse – Horse not to have won 3 blue ribbons.

Novice Rider – Rider not to have won 3 blue ribbons.

Rookie – Rider not to have shown in a gaited horse pleasure rail class prior to January 1, 2019.

Ranch Horse – The Ranch Horse reflects suitability and qualities of a horse used as a working western horse. It is exceptionally responsive, willing, and quiet. All gaits are performed correctly with effortlessness, efficiency, and stamina.

Call of the Class for Ranch Horse Class

- Breed specific walk, intermediate gait, working walk, breed specific walk, lope and hand gallop, breed specific walk, working walk, reverse away from the rail at the working walk, breed specific walk, intermediate gait, working walk, breed specific walk, lope, hand gallop, breed specific walk, working walk, and proceed to line-up.
- A halt on the rail will be called from any gait.
- Reverse
 - After the halt on the rail, the horse may be asked to reverse. When asked to reverse after the halt on the rail, the horse must execute a 180-degree turn on the haunches.
 - When asked to reverse while in motion, the horse reverses at the working walk.
- The horse stands square in the line-up.
- Horse reins back a minimum of four steps and completes a 360-degree neck reined turn on the haunches in either direction.
- A side pass in either direction may be requested. Each horse will be pulled from the line-up for the side pass.

<u>Tack & Attire</u> - Western tack, equipment, and attire are required: long sleeved shirt with collar, tie, scarf or bolo; Western boots; Western hat or helmet; chaps or chinks optional; belt; Western saddle; Western bridle

Fun Classes

All the Fun Classes are open to all gaited breeds

Egg Stomp – timed event, individual riders line up mounted at a starting line across one end of the arena. One egg for each rider will be at the opposite end of arena, in front of you. At the start command, run straight to your egg and get your horse to stomp on it. When egg is stomped, run back to your spot at the starting line. Fastest time wins.

Magazine Race – timed individual rider, page # called out, rider races down to magazine, jumps off horse, finds page # & rips it out, jumps back on horse and races back to start line.

Barrel Racing & Pole Bending – per TWHBEA Versatility Rules

Egg & Spoon – Eggs to be balanced on teaspoons. Spoons held with one hand with no fingers to balance the egg. Horses are to be shown at gaits specified by the judge. Last rider holding their egg wins the class.

Waterglass – per TWHBEA Versatility Rules

Apparel & Tack Not a combination of English, Western, & Other

English apparel and tack for English classes per the NWHA rulebook and Western apparel and tack for Western classes. Breed-specific apparel and tack in OGB classes.

Trail Obstacle – English or Western apparel and tack or breed-specific.

Casual attire is permitted for fun classes.
