You may camp on the grounds – there are no hook-ups.

- \* TP – Trail Pleasure
- \* CP – Country Pleasure
- \* ADP – All Day Pleasure
- \* OGB – Open Gaited Breed
- \* AOT – Amateur/Owned/Trained
- \* Open – any breed
- \* OT - either English or Western Tack
- \* English tack must be used in English classes and western tack must be used in Western classes and cannot be a combination of both
- \* Rookie Class – must be rider's 1st year showing a TP, CP or ADP horse in a rail class
- \* Junior Horse – horses 5 & under
- \* Novice Classes (except for Trail Obstacle) - horse cannot have won more than 3 blue ribbons
- \* Apparel – Dress is informal, but neat (Please – no t-shirts or baseball caps!)
- \* Boots are required
- \* Safety helmets permitted & encouraged

Classes 23 & 27 are for riders 12 & under and are designed to encourage youth participation in a fun, learning environment. These will be judged classes. Each youth may have an adult walking alongside of the horse, but adult may not touch the horse unless help is needed for safety reasons.

ADP & CP horses may cross-enter in these divisions, but TP cannot cross-enter divisions at this show.
