Following notices pertain to Pleasure show only:

- All Novice Rider/Horse classes are walk/trot and are designed for young/inexperienced riders/horses.
- Rider/Horse combos in Novice are not eligible to go in other classes.
 - Exceptions:
 - Horse may be ridden in one (1) age group class by different rider in the case of Novice rider [if two people are showing same horse, all riders MUST register at the same time. Horse and riders will be DQ'd and forfeit money if they do not].
 - Rider may ride different horses in various other classes in the case of a Novice horse
- Horses may enter an age division class and/or one
 (1) of the following: (horse may not be shown by two different riders unless one is a Novice or Leadline)
 - o Arab
 - o Gaited
 - o Open
- "Open" English Eq/Pleasure and Western Horse/Pleasure classes are open to Horses not already in Novice, Arab or Gaited classes. Riders in Novice, Arab or Gaited classes may ride different horses in "Open" classes.
- Classes #49, 50 and 51 are actually Open to ALL horses, does not matter if they showed Gaited, Arab or Age Division (If they showed Novice, they may not canter even if the pattern calls for a canter/lope). Same horse <u>may not</u> enter both class 50 and class 51.
- Leadline class is either English or Western. Rider and handler should be dressed in the same discipline. There are no restrictions on the horse showing in other classes.
- Please fill out contact information if you would like (are eligible) to receive Arabian's Unplugged Points.
- ADP/CP classes will be governed by the rules from Minnesota Walking Horse Association <u>WWW.MWHA.com</u>
 - All ADP/CP classes will count towards Gaited High Point
